- 2. Students is asked to identify the composers of the vocal compositions from the first three tracks of the CD provided. They also have to identify the mudhras sung in the compositions. Please play the tracks from the CD provided as follows:
 - i. Play Track 1 from the CD. This is the full keertana.
 - ii. Play Track 2 from the CD. This is the charanam of the kriti.
 - iii. Play Track 3 from the CD. This also the charanam of the kriti.

Note: If the students have identified the composer and the mudhra – then don't waste time by playing the full track. Go on to the next track.

- 3. A vocal musical form is recorded as Track 4. Please play Track 4 and ask the students to listen carefully and identify the musical form sung by the singers.
- 4. Please play track 5 from the CD. Please ask the students to listen carefully and to identify the following:
 - i. The main musical instrument.
 - ii. The two (2) percussion instruments in the music track.
 - iii. The raga of the composition.
 - iv. The tala of the composition.
